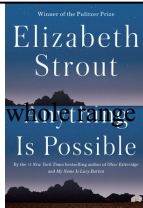
Book Discussion Group

The Sisters Pick

Anything Is Possible by Elizabeth Strout explores the whole range of human emotion through the dramas of people struggling to understand themselves and others. Here are two sisters: One trades self-respect for a wealthy husband while the other finds in the pages of a book a kindred spirit who changes her life. The janitor at the local school has his faith tested in an encounter with an isolated man he has come to help; a grown daughter longs for mother love even as she comes to accept her mother's happiness in a foreign country; and the adult Lucy Barton (the heroine of *My Name Is Lucy Barton*, the author's celebrated bestseller) returns to visit her siblings after seventeen years of absence.
